1. The enclosed INPR was submitted to us for action (encl 1). After reviewing the INPR, we nonconcur with the recommendation of risk assessment code (RAC) 1. Ordnance and explosives (OE) residue has been found on this site in the past. The U.S. Navy used this site as a bombing and rocket training range for approximately a year during WWII. Practice bombs were reported being found and also something that was identified as a rocket motor from the description. The site visit yielded no OE. The site, located on the beach, is now a state park and there is concern that the ocean waves will uncover buried ordnance. We recommend a phased EE/CA be scheduled for the following site:


